<b>Visa application</b>	<p>Accepted exchange students will receive an official invitation prepared by the Federal Migration Service of the Russian Federation or the University of Tyumen (depending on the sending country). The process of preparing the invitation may take <b>up to five weeks</b>.</p> <p>Students will then have to apply for a student visa via the Russian Consulate in their home country. The process may take <b>up to one month</b>.</p> <p>An initial visa will be issued <b>for 90 days</b>. Upon arrival in Tyumen, the International Office will extend the visa till the end of the study period. All the information concerning visa issues will be sent to incoming exchange students.</p>

<b>Welcome Orientation</b>	<p>All international students are required to take part in the Welcome Orientation. It will take place in the beginning of each semester.</p> <p>The University of Tyumen also provides international students with a Russian culture immersion programme throughout the whole academic year.</p>
